This Show Jumping Rally is governed by The USPC Handbook and Rules for Show Jumping Competition 2008, the Show Jumping Spring Newsletter 2009, and The USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Competition 2007.

ENTRY FEES:

\$60.00 per horse/rider combination and includes 1 night stabling. No charge for Horse Managers.

ALL Out of State Horses must have a current Negative Coggins in Compliance with your State Laws. Copy of which must be included with your entry forms.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. This rally is open to all Pony Club Members in good standing.
2. This rally will be held as a team competition.
 - * Teams will be composed of 3 or 4 riders and a horse manager.
 - * Teams can be made up of riders with different ratings and competing in different divisions.
 - * Scramble teams for competitors without a team will be created.
3. A rider competes at the level of his horse regardless of his/her rating.
4. A horse can only compete in 1 division.
5. A rider may enter more than 1 horse in the competition. 1 horse must be designated as the team horse in the entry form.

6. To qualify for division awards a rider/horse combination must ride in 3 classes, 1 of which MUST be the equitation class noted for your division. Each rider may only ride in 1 equitation class.
7. A rider/horse combination may ride in a maximum of 4 classes in their division.
8. If you are attempting to qualify for Championships, please make sure you understand the rules as posted in the USPC Handbook and Rules for Show Jumping Competition 2008 and the Show Jumping Spring Newsletter 2009.

DIVISIONS (LEVELS):

- Grasshopper : Cross Rail – 2'
- Green Jumper : 2'-2'9"
- Small/Medium Ponies : 2'-2'9", ponies not to exceed 13.2 hands
- Large Ponies : 2'6"-3'3", 13.2 to 14.2 hands
- Developing Horse/Rider: 2'9"-3'
- Horse I : 2'6"-3'3"
- Horse II : 2'9"-3'6"
- Horse III : 3'-3'9"
- Horse IV : 3'3"-4'

CLASSES:

All Classes will be run under USPC Show Jumping Rules Articles 30, 31, 33 and 34. Ties will not be broken. Jump-offs will not be held unless noted (JO). When noted, Jump Offs will run according to Table II 2(a).

ARENA:

Jumping will take place in a sandy/soil outdoor arena measuring approx. 160' x 220'. Warm up arena and jumps will be provided.

ATTIRE:

Attire for C1's and higher must be either correctly informal or formal. Attire for D rated competitors must be neat, clean, and workmanlike. USPC approved (SEI/ASTM) helmets are mandatory for ALL riders. Medical Armband must be worn. See Horse Management Rulebook for more information. Pony club pins must be worn.

HORSE MANAGEMENT:

Horse Management will be judged for the duration of the rally.

Each team will need to set up a tack room.

Forms used will be #2B One Day Rally USPC Horse Management Required Equipment Checklist, #3A,B, or C USPC Horse Management Turnout Inspection, #4A USPC Horse Management Daily Sheet.

SCORING:

1. Teams and Divisions – faults accumulated from top 3 rounds will be added to factored horse management and written test scores. Equitation scores and Jump Off scores (bonus points) will then be subtracted. Fewest faults wins.

2. Horse management scores will be factored by .25.

AWARDS:

Team Ribbons through 6th.

Horse Management Ribbons for top 3 teams.

Individual Ribbons through 3rd for each division.

COACHING:

Each team MUST be accompanied by a coach. No competitor may jump in a warm-up arena without a coach present. The coach and the chaperone shall not be the same person. Coaches must sign the coach's form and be included with your entries.

CHAPERONES:

Each club must provide 1 designated chaperone at least 21 years old for every team. The enclosed Chaperone's duties form must be filled out and signed by each chaperone and returned with your entry. Please list the names of the competitors each chaperone is responsible for on the form by the signature.

VOLUNTEERS:

Please send the names of at least 2 volunteers per club. If there is a job preference, please list or email the organizer.

STABLING:

Stabling fees are included for Thursday night and Friday day in the entry fees. If you need additional stabling, 12'x12' panel pens will be available for \$10 per night per horse at Southwind Ranch. You are responsible for the care of your horse and for stripping stalls or cleaning pens before you leave.

FOOD:

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 84, take Jerome exit #168.

If you are East bound turn right, if you are West bound turn left. You will be turning away from Wal-Mart and towards Subway. Go past Subway and take the first right which is 300 S Road. (Do not take a right at Bob Barton which is just past the eastbound freeway exit.) Go approx $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to Southwind Ranch. You will see a sign at the driveway. Enter and go through metal gate.
